# **Request for Determination of Applicability**

# The City of Marlborough Dept. of Public Works request confirmation of the wetland resource areas along various streets within the City of Marlborough

No one from the DPW was present. Ms. Ryder explained that the DPW needs to resubmit the 5 year Vegetation Management Plan to the state. The Commission is required to verify the wetland resource areas along all roadways that require roadside maintenance. The DPW submitted plans for review showing all wetland and stream crossings. The Commission reviewed the plans and Ms. Ryder said she'd checked them in the field. The Commission <u>noted that Reservoir St. and Bolton St. and Hemenway St.</u> Extension need to be included. The Commission voted 5-0 to approve the plans as <u>amended above.</u>

# Notice of Intent

Forest St (between Martinangelo Dr. and Bartlett St. - Mass Electric Company (d/b/a National Grid)

David Cowell of BSC group was present representing Mass Electric Co. The proposal is to install a 10 ft. x 18 ft. manhole and approximately 1,100 ft. of duct bank within the west shoulder of Forest St. No work is proposed in the resource area, but a small amount of work is proposed in the City's no disturb 20' buffer zone. Wetlands were reflagged in the field. They will need to install several manholes to pull the cables through the conduit, but these will be outside the resource area. After some discussion about soil contamination which they will check with Partners Health Care about old apple orchards being there, and that no storage of soil can happen on the pavement. The Commission <u>voted 5-0 to issue an Order of Conditions with standard conditions and additional conditions to address the items noted above. The Commission reminded the applicant that they would need a road opening permit from the DPW.</u>
