I have owned 123 Chestnut Street for 12 years. For 11.5 years the sign out front said "no parking here to corner". It was changed in September because of "an existing parking regulation".

There are very good long term tenants in this building. Some families have lived there for as long as I've owned it. This new sign is causing an undue hardship for them. While they used to have to juggle cars or find alternate parking in the winter months, it has become an every day occurrence.

We know the housing stock in this neighborhood was built long before there were 2 income, 2 car families. Are there any remedies available to alleviate this situation?
