The MA Cultural Council sent us an order form for a \$79.30 banner or \$51.88 poster. Consensus: we would do better to spend that money direction on cultural performances, but we might like a less expensive, disposable paper version we could post and distribute to grantees for display when they perform.

No public showed up at our 10/1 evening informational session at the Library despite our press release and listing on medwaytoday (the unofficial website for Medway information); but we had a nice time together waiting for them.

The MA Cultural Council sent word that they can't yet tell us this year's grant amount because the budget has not yet been passed. They suggest we assume we'll get about as much money as last year. They further recommend that we put off final decisions until after the budget is passed.

Several applicants did not specify a venue. We will send each applicants a copy of our local guidelines when we send them their approval/disapproval letters, so they will know for next year.

Actions Taken:

Action Items:

2. Grace will clarify dates for the Memoir Writing Class and Humor Workshop with Missy Dziczek at the Senior Center.
3. Grace will ask whether the Library would be a venue for the Glickman and Toledo shows.
4. Iyawata will find out whether Medway Cable Access carries Audio Journal.
5. Wendy will call MA Audubon to clarify what fraction of the project they are asking us to fund.
6. Wendy will call Richard Hamelin to discuss possible venues.
7. Wendy will look into the cost of a small paper poster.
