Meeting called to order by Barbara Maffeo at 11:15 Am Present were Barbara Maffeo, President, Wendy Rowe, Treasurer, Iyawata Barbara Schneider, Secretary, Priscilla Howker and Grace Hoag.

The minutes for 11/29/01 were approved by unanimous vote.

The Treasurer's report given by Wendy Rowe, as follows: The Ma Legislature approved the funding for the next fiscal year. The amount available for Medway in ( Fiscal 2002) is \$4940. In regards to Fiscal 2001, there have been no submissions for payment after 9/01. These

The Medway Library submission for Rick Golden was not reimbursed as of this date.

Total for above is \$ 925. Currently on hand is \$1,228.47. When the programs are paid the remaining balance will be \$303.47 All members voted to keep this amount for administrative expenses.

Barbara Maffeo circulated a letter to go to the local newspapers from the Medway Cultural Council regarding the lack of publicity for the arts and local performances funded by the Cultural Council.

The members then completed the selection of grantees. Wendy Rowe moved to substitute the Council on Aging Humor Workshop for the Audio Journal. Clafin Hill funding will be reduced by \$50. The final amount granted in Fall 2001 is \$4920.

**This will leave an additional \$20 for administrative funds if needed.**
