#### 5 Membership Issues:

Bob Tucker commented on the Town of Millis presentation to the public regarding the Stretch Code. Bob said that the Millis may be considering whether or not to adopt the stretch code, in part, due to the anticipated not-to-distant modification to the basic building code that would reduce the improvement of the stretch code relative to the standard code. Also, Millis is concerned that if they adopt the stretch code in the next few months that the actual stretch code may change just after it is adopted. This was expressed as a concern from contractors in town.
