-Events at the mansion for the month.

3. Dennis Hill has spoken to John D'Agastino. He will have estimates for the phase II of the AC project and installation of a chimney flue liner by mid March.
4. Dennis Hill will be discussing with Charlton Fence Company repairs needed to the black wrought iron fence on the Elm Street side of the property.
5. The outside faucet noise from behind the gift shop has been resolved.

New Business;

-The Task Force has been invited to the Millbury Disability Committee meeting this

Thursday. Deb Dimmick has expressed concerns over whether the Bicentennial Birthday Party event is ready for the disabled. Their concerns are with any exhibits on the 2nd floor. Mary Lou Mulhane, vice chair of the Millbury Historical Committee is also invited. There would need to be a designated area for the disabled to access a presentation on the first floor (visual & audio). There are also concerns with events for the rest of the year, and if they will be accessible to the handicapped.


Suggestions for the above:
