Minutes

Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Approval of minutes from Sept. 5 meeting. Motion to accept by Rob, seconded by Ron, unanimously approved without discussion.

Treasurer's report:

Committee considered invoice in the amount of \$4,947.75 to Arcadia Publishing for 500 copies of the new book, "Images of America: Millbury." Motion by Carole, seconded by Joyce, unanimously approved without discussion. Various other invoices were signed. Joyce noted that the MBC budget stands at \$154,008.39.

Finance/Fundraising committee

Vote on 28 additional wooden "Millbury" signs, for \$224. Motion by Joyce, seconded by Carole, unanimously approved without discussion.

Rob recommended that price of glasses would be \$10, or four for \$35, and that the Asa Waters ornament would be \$10 each. Motion by Ron, second by Carole, unanimously approved without discussion.

Events committee

Ball committee and events committee met last month. Ron said MBC has reached out to Lions Club for volunteers for the parade, re-enactment and other events. Bill said Lions Club has approved use of their trailed by MBC for the re-enactment.

Bill and Roger explained some details of the re-enactment logistics. There is assigned parking for MBC volunteers and handicapped visitors, across from Pearson's Dairy. Volunteers will have lanyards, t-shirts and reflective vests. Portable toilets will be located at each parking lot. On Thursday, Friday and Friday night volunteers are needed for signage and logistics. 20 Scouts will be helping.
