Chairman Donald Flynn opened the hearing.

Robert Murphy, applicant's representative, was present along with applicant, Domenic Murgo. Revised plans were submitted. Mr. Murphy explained there is now an existing conditions plan and a proposed plan, as requested by the board. He discussed additional/revised information submitted tonight including the SWPPP which explains the complete sequence of the project. He said, as requested, the Buffer Zone line has been extended

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through on the revised plan and the scale has been changed so as to make plan easier to read. Representative explained plan now includes details regarding the permanent measuring device to be placed in each of the two infiltration basins. Discussion ensued. Dave Palleiko questioned calculations regarding soil logs & infiltration and Mr. Murphy said these were addressed in the Notice of Intent. Chairman Flynn commented on portion of SWPPP that states “common sense” approach will be used in maintaining temporary detention basins during the project, explaining this may not be clear enough for the contractor. Chairman noted an error in the SWPPP where it refers to an incorrect subdivision as well as other mistakes in the report. Mr. Murphy said he’d correct the errors. The board agreed that if they closed the hearing, an Order of Conditions will be issued only after receiving the corrected SWPPP.

Ron Stead motioned to close the hearing; seconded by Jim Boucher; voted unanimously.
