AQUARION Request for a Determination of Applicability
PUBLIC MEETING Oak Pond Avenue
Vice-Chairman Ron Stead read legal ad.

Justine Carroll & Marie Rivers of Tata & Howard were present on behalf of Aquarion Water Co. to explain proposal for cleaning & redevelopment of Oak Pond Well so as to maintain well capacity. They explained well was last cleaned four years ago in accordance with a Negative Determination issued by the CC. Ms. Carroll explained well will be cleaned using a physical method initially; chemical method may be necessary if capacity is not regained after initial cleaning. She said all vehicles will use existing access road. Work to take 2 to 3 days to complete. Board discussed proposal. Paul DiCicco asked and was told, only one tanker is necessary and resulting sediment from tanker will be removed from site. Ms. Carroll described for the CC the temporary sedimentation basin proposed. She explained her company does the engineering & design of the project while a contractor does the work overseen by Tata & Howard. Tony Cameron recommended the CC be notified when work is to begin.

The board agreed a filing of a Notice of Intent (NOI) is not required.
A Negative Determination will be issued.




The Commission received a copy of the Blackstone River Watershed 2013 Water Quality Monitoring Sites map from The Blackstone River Coalition.

Mat Ashmankas motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:00 p.m.; seconded by Paul DiCicco; voted unanimously.




