Notice of Intent

230 West Main Street – Abandonment of existing septic system and new municipal sewer connection with associated site work

Michael Andrade from Graves Engineering was present for the applicant. Mike explained that the housing authority owns the duplex where the work will be done. The house is about 15 feet higher than the road. The septic at the rear of the property will be abandoned. Mike said the work is all within the buffer zone. Erosion controls will be put in and there is a designated stockpile area. Mike said they would like to do the work this fall. Paul asked how far the sewer line goes. Ron said to the Sutton town line. Paul asked what will be done with the old septic. Mike said it will be drained and filled. Tony asked how long they will be in the street. Mike said hopefully a day or two. Tony asked how far the nearest catch basin is. Mike pointed it out on the plans. Paul asked how much room there is to the lake. Mike said less than 10 feet in some spots. Mike said the work will be done on a dry day. Paul made a motion to close the hearing; tony seconded; voted unanimously.


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


