- Holding Tank System Prepared For Linda & William Carig Trustees of the Paine Homestead Trust

Mike Burke was present on applicant's behalf to propose construction of a 2500 gallon tight (holding) tank approximately 65 ft. from Ramshorn Pond. He explained the lot is small so due to constraints, applicant cannot put in a septic system. Mr. Burke said the proposed tight tank has been approved by the Board of Health. Existing septic tank to be removed and collapsed. Tight tank will be constructed beside abandoned system. Small amount of excavated fill will be spread, used on site. Mr. Burke said it's to be a one to two day project. He stated, mitigation is proposed – row of staked hay bales, however not indicated on plan. The board allowed Mr. Burke to draw-in the proposed mitigation on the plan & initial & date said revision. Board reviewed and discussed proposal. Tony Cameron suggested the hay bale line be pushed back (along 96 contour & near driveway) and Mr. Burke so noted on plan this evening. Mat Ashmankas stated concern that if project takes longer than expected, silt fencing may be necessary along with the hay bales. After some discussion, board members determined silt fence is not necessary. Audience member Roger Leland, representative for the Paine family, commented that he was pleased with the plan prepared & presented by the family's engineer, Mr. Burke and said proposed project will be an improvement.

Tony Cameron motioned to close the hearing; seconded by Mathew Ashmankas; voted unanimously to close.

Board voted unanimously to approve proposal.

An Order of Conditions will be issued.
