Previous Minutes

Lenny Mort motion to accept the minutes from June 21, 2013 with one correction, adding “vice chair” to the nominations. Tom seconded. Unanimously approved.

New Business

- Steve Landry from Aggregate Industries and Dave LaVallee from Andrews Survey and Engineering, Inc. (Dave’s number is 508-865-6544)
 - Processing materials is down, economy is down. The end is “near” for that site, within maybe 5-10 years. Until that happens, they will continue with their current plan to do reclamation.
 - Keep site open, will keep permit open, though production is slow.
 - Al – would like to send the Civil Site engineers to review the site.
 - Dave LaValle would be happy to meet with them and tour their property. Mondays and Tuesdays are good days.
 - They will need a new application, okay to leave for Dave at the Town Clerk’s office.
- Al – would like Briely Pond to come before the board for an update. Al spoke to John Burns and he feels as though he is done with earth removal at their site.
 - Tom suggested that our engineer go to the site to do a final review. If there is not enough monies in their fund, there is enough in the general fund to cover the final on site review.
- Brian Turbitt rescheduled his presentation for August.
- Murgu Trucking will be finishing up their permit with us as well.
- Autumn Gates – Al was on site there and saw activity, clearing lots, some material on the side.
 - Request that they come before the board. Al will call Steve Gallow.
- Al also visited the former Millbury Savings Bank site on 146. Taylor Right is doing work there now. Al said that they did plan to “move out” material from the site due to foundation issues. Al will give them an application for a permit.
 - Tom – if the earth is contaminated, the Board of Health and DEP will need to be notified. The material will need to be analyzed.

- Anna suggested that the Planning Board be notified that this may have not gone through the proper channels, and recommended that Al notify either Bob Spain and or the Planning Board.
- Lenny and Tom thought that there should be a business card to hand to people when they go on site. A general card with a line across the bottom for individuals to sign their name. All agreed it would be a good idea.
- Al and Tom will go to the site this week, maybe tomorrow, 7/17/13.





Lenny Mort motioned to adjourn. Anna Lewandowski seconded. Unanimously approved.




