Call to Order: 8:40 A.M.

<u>Acceptance of Past Minutes</u>: Approval of the Minutes of 11 March 2011 was postponed until the next meeting.

Reports:

- Jim reported that at the meeting of 22 March the Selectmen approved the Wind Turbine and Met Tower studies going forward.
- Bob, Jim, and Laurie will examine the *Weston & Sampson* payment plan.
- The Pearsons wish to view/copy documents about the cell tower and the wind turbine projects.
- Town Manager Bob Spain told the Committee that we can have between \$500 & \$1,000 for an energy audit of the Town Hall.

Rick has done an comprehensive and efficient job of pulling the *Energy Reduction Plan* together. The high school continues to be the biggest consumer of energy. If it could be reduced from 48,000 BTU's (?) to 39,000 BTU's (?) over five years, that would be a tremendous savings.

A few other things remain to be investigated and plugged into the template in order to come up with a 20% reduction over five years:

• Jim and Brad need to obtain the Prism contact's input.

- Bob Spain will provide information on fuel discrepancies.
- Jim and Bob will confer with the HVAC contractor for more information on the Town Hall's energy audit.
- Brad will check on the Senior Center (Judy O'Connor) to see what kinds of things can be done to reduce its energy output.
- Sharon will check on the Asa Waters' Mansion (Catherine Elliot) to see what kinds of things can be done to reduce its energy output.
- How about insulating the second floor of Fire Station #1?
- How about checking on water conservation policies throughout the town?
- Check with Brad Lange about water-pumping stations. Any changes in the last two years are good for this survey.
- Does Wheelabrator have an energy engineer there? Perhaps we can capitalize on their energy savings. Likewise for the Upper Blackstone Waste Treatment Abatement Plant.

In addition, Rick is going to devise a spreadsheet for savings for each candidate. He has a list of potential savings opportunities e.g. LED traffic lights, streetlights, shutting off every-other light, bus-idling policies etc.

What would the savings be annually in terms of fuel oil etc. if these opportunities were investigated and new ideas implemented?

The Committee will make a briefing before the Selectmen on 12 April 2011 at 7:00 to bring them up to speed and then present a more formalized version on 10 May 2011.
