Meeting called to order at 2:06 PM by Chairperson, Rick Bedard

A team from Good Energy was present to give a presentation on Community Aggregation Project. This is a bulk purchase of electricity (municipal aggregation) for residential and small business use. Stefano Loretto explained what the company does. Good Energy buys power (electricity) in bulk and sells it to communities. John O'Rourke and Stefano answered many questions from the committee. Rick Bedard recommended tabling any action until a later meeting, where all missing members could participate.
