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Minutes of July 19th and Oct 11th were accepted as presented.

1. Laurie read Rick Bedard's report. He reported that Project #1 was complete with a cost of \$11,389.30. The Town's portion was \$7914.30. He is still working on the refrigeration controls project. The Honeywell Controls project at High School is still on going. A motion was made by Jim Dunn to pay the Prism Energy bill of \$7914.30. Seconded by Bob Blackman. So Voted.
2. Laurie explained the changes she made to Green Energy Community report.
3. Laurie presented a proposal from HKA for design work on the HVAC project at the Municipal Office Building. The cost will be \$1000.00. Jim Dunn made a motion to accept the proposal. Seconded by Brad Turner. Voted.
4. Dunkin Chapman from Northeast Real Estate Solutions came to the Committee to give information and update on a photovoltaic project next to Wheelabrator plant. A question and answer session occurred. They tried to explain what their role would be if they were hired for the project.
5. Solarize project- Highlights of the Project were discussed. However the project did have success, it was not the success that was anticipated.
6. The wind turbine is complete. Data report will be sent to members. The grant proposal required that a presentation on results be presented to the Town. Laurie will try to set up a time for the presentation for the Board of Selectmen. The bottom line however, is that the report indicated the site as unacceptable.
7. It was discussed about proceeding with looking at possible sites for a solar farm. Jim Dunn, Brad Turner, and Bob Blackmen will view the two sites (landfill and sewer plant) to determine acceptability. They will try to get a report back before next meeting.
