S.O.G. #23 DRESS UNIFORM GUIDELINE

Board members agreed to delete the last paragraph and add that anything with a badge, whether embroidered or metal, or the Millbury Fire Department patch will fall under the Dress Uniform Guideline and will be regulated by it.

OLD & NEW BUSINESS

- Chief Rudge gave the following truck repair report based on P.M.'s done on 11/3/14:
 - Engine 1: siren not working properly, radio not transmitting properly, water leak at pump, cab needs welding repairs, strobe light out above driver's door.
 - Rescue 1: need "o" rings for hydraulic tools
 - Tower 1: need DEF fluid, roof saw needs repair
 - Engine 2: front cross lay leaking by charging hose, driver's side upper red light out, passenger side rear bumper light out and quartz light out
 - Engine 4: no report submitted
 - Hose 1: roof bar light not working properly, need anti-freeze
 - Engine 3: rear flood light missing? Foam A & B light out, generator mount broken, air line for on-spots not connected
 - Forestry 1: needs brake fluid
 - Engine 5: generator parts on order, handle for deck gun, strobe lights out, pump panel lights on right side out.
- Fire drills will be conducted at the schools on November 21, 2014.
- Repairs at Steelcraft have not been completed.
- The master box at Barrday has been repaired.
- There has been no reply from the Town Manager concerning changing the name of the Length of Service Awards Program.
- The DPW is looking for permission to install an additional solar panel and radio at the Butler Farm.
- Chief Rudge met with Steven Kosiba, EMA, to require ID's in all their radios and to let the Board know the location of the radios with the fire department frequency.
- Chief Rudge gave an update on the project at Landscape Etc. A hydrant will be installed on their side of the street and a water flow test is required.




- Chief Rudge gave an update on the solar farm being installed on Auburn Road. The access road must accommodate Tower 1.
