Meeting Minutes October 19, 2016 Town Hall

- Meeting called to order at 6:02 PM
- Fred Moseley reviewed a letter received by the town regarding ATV damage
- Rob McNeil provided an update on the McCracken Road Project
 - The project is in the State TIP program
 - Project limits are from the mall to Greenwood Street and include a bridge widening, roadway improvements and a roundabout at Greenwood Street.
 - A waiver from the Healthy Transportation Policy has been granted which relieves the project from requiring sidewalks on both sides of the roadway.
 - 25% design has been submitted.
 - Additional test pits are required in the location of the bridge.
 - A public hearing on the Project is likely to occur in the Spring of 2017.
 - Construction schedule is anticipated for 2020 with a projected value of 8.5 to 9 million dollars.
- Rob McNeil provided an update on the South Main Street Project
 - The board approved performing additional survey to support the project
 - The public utilities affected by the Project have been contacted indicating the town's intentions with the project and requesting the respective utilities needs to accommodate them.
 - Hopeful that utility relocation work can begin in the summer of 2017
 - 3 public information sessions were conducted with approximately 40 participants in attendance total.
 - Additional public meetings are anticipated for Jan / Feb 2017 to review conceptual drawings.
- Rob McNeil provided an update to the South Main Street Bridge repairs
 - State has secured a contractor
 - Town has prepped the site for construction to commence
 - Awaiting contractor to mobilize
 - Extent of the repairs is only to fix the section of the bridge that has separated for the main structure by a horizontal drilling and grouting program. Phase 2 of the repair would entail excavation and crack repairs. Timing of the second phase is unknown.
- Board discussed creating a plan to prioritize the town's roadway improvement needs
- Discussions were had about increasing the towns annual crack sealing budget
- The CMRPC contract was discussed
- Rob McNeil indicated no change in status on the Wedgewood Lane project has occurred pending negotiations with the owners of 5 Wedgewood Lane. A scheduled meeting between the town and the residents of 5 Wedgewood Lane was cancelled by the residents.



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- Rob McNeil provided an update on the town's small bridge inspections
 - There are 33-35 bridges which are owned by the town
 - A contract for inspection is expected to be signed soon and the inspections will commence.
- Next meeting date was not set.
- Meeting adjourned.
