## **Grafton Street Pumping Station**

Joe Boccardo from AECOM submitted pay req #3 for payment to Fed Corp in the amount of \$103,000.00 which is a progress payment, for work in accordance with plans and specs. Want to finish the punch list, damage done to Grafton St by the excavator, did not saw cut the edge of the road and manhole has a crack. Fed Corp will mill out damages and are going to re-pave and refine the gutter, also fix the cracking. Total completion will be approximately 6 weeks. AECOM is waiting for list from Fed Corp. Warranty is 1 year from date of the pump station going on line which is 7/10/12. Joe, AECOM credit to project approximately \$7,000.00, will adjust all paperwork and submit it with final payment

#### **New Business**

146/West Main St Intersection, we cleaned out all the sewer pipes in the area, there are a lot of pipes that are bellowing with a lot of debris in the base of the pipe. Rob is trying to get Mass Highway to replace the sewer line from River Street o Elmwood St. Mass Highway will be replacing the service line for drainage from the bridge to the Blackstone River. This intersection will be stated in 2014 but should have 25% of the design by Christmas

Changing the Alarm system at all the pumping station, the alarm company is American Alarm which has an office in Auburn, one account and any changed can be made at any time, by select sewer personal. All alarms will have new panels, and cellular service which means that the 11 accounts that we have with ADT will be turned into one and we can also eliminate Verizon for the phone service at the pump stations. Also the fire system at Providence St Pump station is out to date for approximately 10 years. That will also be brought up to date.
