**ITEM TWO – APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Marcia Landry motioned to approve the May 9, 2016 meeting minutes as submitted; Gil Picard seconded; a unanimous vote of approval was obtained.

**ITEM THREE – OLD BUSINESS**

Keith Dobie was present to discuss his request to have his sister's remains buried at her grave in Central Cemetery. Mr. Dobie was previously advised that in order to do so, he must provide proof, as an heir, to the rights of the burial license for the lot in question. He questioned the Commission this evening as to why he must provide such materials, commenting that this is unreasonable as well as costly - he has had to hire an attorney for this matter. Rob McNeil explained that because it's a legal issue, protocol is that such a matter must go to Town Council for review.

**ITEM FOUR – NEW BUSINESS**

Rob McNeil prepared the following documents for the Cemetery Commission's review and signatures:

- Re: Request from Pepin Granite for monument installation at Central Cemetery for *Beaucage*: Marcia Landry motioned to approve request; Randy Mogren seconded; a unanimous vote of approval was obtained.
- Re: Request from Whitinsville Monument Works for monument installation at Central Cemetery for *Mello*: Marcia Landry motioned to approve request contingent on Michael Mello providing the office with a copy of the licensed burial rights; Gil Picard seconded; a unanimous vote of approval was obtained.

**ITEM SIX – OTHER TOPICS**

Marcia Landry asked about the damaged archway at Central Cemetery exit. Rob McNeil said that an insurance claim had been filed to replace the damaged archway and that he would check on the status of the matter.

Marcia Landry asked if the Commission needs to renew contractor services soon for the cemetery. Rob McNeil said the contract with Tender Touch Landscaping expires the end of June.
