**ITEM ONE – CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Picard called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m. Those in attendance are noted below:

**ITEM TWO – APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Marcia Landry motioned to approve the following meeting minutes as submitted:

Nov. 10, 2014, Dec. 8, 2014, Jan. 12, 2015, Mar. 9, 2015, Apr. 6, 2015, Jun. 8, 2015, Aug. 10, 2015, Sep. 14, 2015, Oct. 19, 2015; Gil Picard seconded; a unanimous vote of approval was obtained.

**ITEM THREE – OTHER TOPICS**

- Stuart Mulhane was present on behalf of Sylvia & Harold Hall of Worcester. Stuart explained the couple's request to be buried in Central Cemetery, Millbury instead of in burial lots that they currently own in Paxton because their previously deceased daughter (and former Millbury resident) is buried in Millbury. Discussion ensued. The Commission voiced concern about considering this request due to their no pre-sale policy, and the fact that the Halls do not reside in Town. Rob McNeil suggested the possibility that there is space between Section 7 & Section 10 and offered to investigate the matter. The Commission agreed to delay any vote regarding this request until after Rob McNeil investigates. Stuart Mulhane will accompany Rob.
- Ronald & Barbara Bonzey of 228 Central St., Auburn were present to seek help in identifying/locating the Central Cemetery burial site of Jon Bonzey (died 1902) and to request placement of a headstone there, which is currently in a cemetery in Auburn. They said they are working with Empire to have the monument moved. Rob McNeil said he would work with the Bonzneys to locate the lot in questions. He would like to meet Mr. Bonzey at the Cemetery. Also, Mr. Bonzey would like to learn who else may be buried with Jon Bonzey and if there are any other open spaces. Rob said he would work with Mr. Bonzey to this end.
- Marcia Landry motioned to approve placement of the monument as proposed; Randy Mogren seconded; a unanimous vote of approval was obtained.
- The Comm. reviewed the proposed FY17 Cemetery Dept. Budget. Rob McNeil advised the Comm. that the amount of Capital Outlay was pulled from the budget & will be submitted as an Article at the Town Meeting, subject to discussion.
- Rob McNeil explained to the Comm. the matter of a refund request received by Bruce & Marion Hodgman of Staten Island, NY. He explained the Hodgmans purchased 10 graves in 1987 for a total amount of \$1,500.00 and as they do not plan on utilizing them they would like to sell them back to the Town. Rob confirmed the 10 lots are empty and the amount paid was \$1,500.00. He said that Town Council has been forwarded all the Hodgmans' correspondence to review and asked the Comm. for any input. The Comm. had no comments or concerns at this time.

**ITEM FOUR – PUBLIC ATTENDEES**

- Matt Mulhane was not present. On Matthew's behalf, Stuart Mulhane started a discussion about burials in Section 10 at Central Cemetery. He & the Comm. discussed current method & procedures when it comes to assigning grave sites. Stuart advised that the 1<sup>st</sup> row tends to be preferred. Rob McNeil stated that the 2<sup>nd</sup> row of Section 10 is more accessible and will start being populated. Marcia Landry commented that the Comm. is to stipulate the rows and lots available at the given time.

- Randy Mogren requested the final cost of the recent cemetery roadway paving project. Rob McNeil will get this information and have it available for the next meeting.




At 6:06 p.m. Gil Picard motioned to adjourn the meeting, Randy Mogren seconded. Meeting adjourned.

This is a single grave of Debra Warfield, her legal name at time of death, who died September 5, 2012

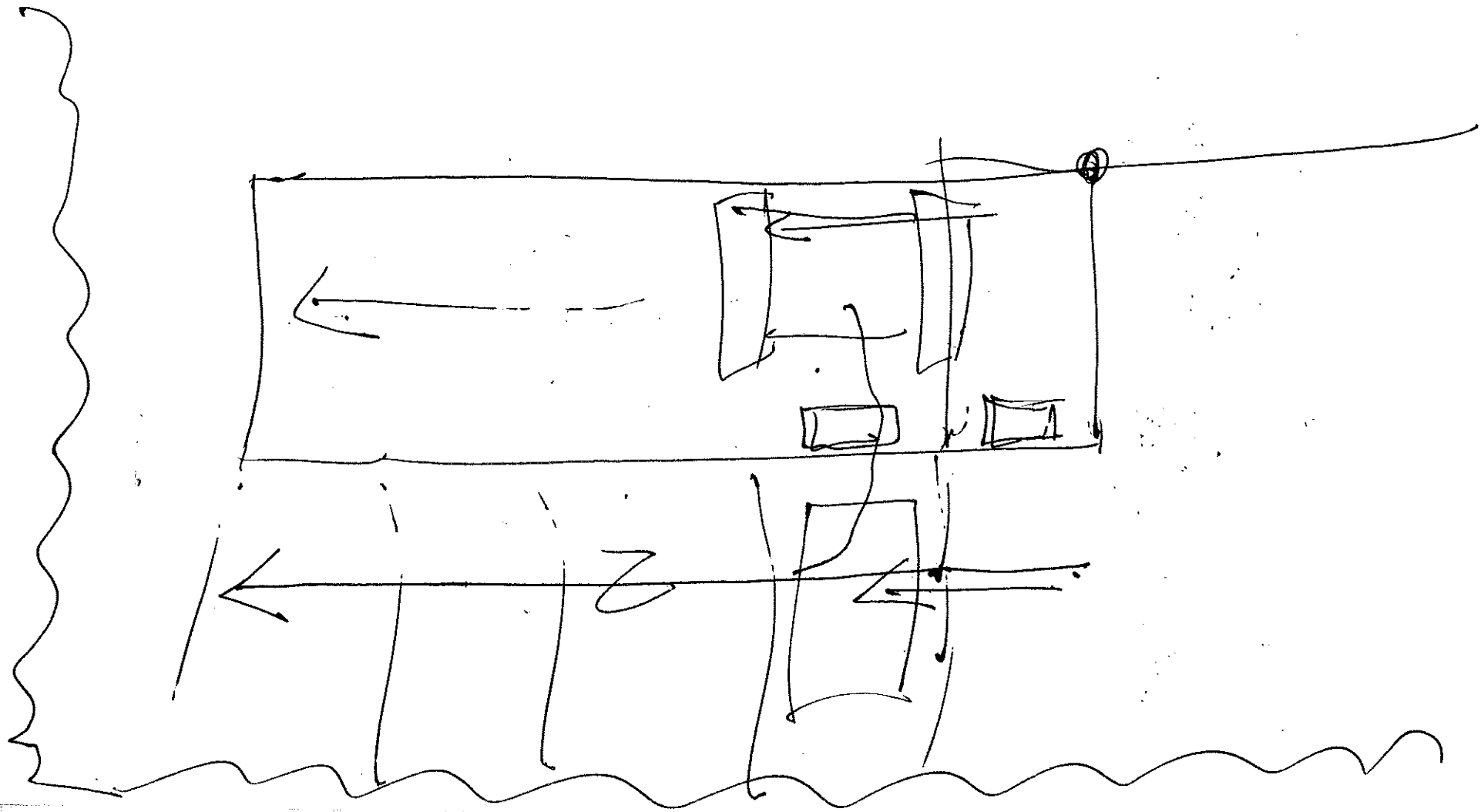
Front of monument on lot reads Hall, her maiden name, and the name on back is Debra K. Hall with dates.

Debra's parents, Harold and Sylvia Hall of 16 Tamar St. in Worcester 01604 would like to be buried with their daughter instead of a lot they own in Worcester County Memorial Park in Paxton. Neither want to be cremated, so two additional graves are necessary. They are residents of Worcester and never lived in Millbury although Sylvia is now living in the daughter's home in Millbury to be cared for since, her health is declining. Their daughter was a resident of Millbury, which made her eligible to purchase a lot, and should have purchased a three grave lot at the time, but family did realized the situation at the time.

Family is asking the commissioners for consideration to purchase two graves which are not marked graves since they are locate at the end of the first row and were not considered possible graves when the new section was surveyed or the possibility of two graves in rear of the single grave.

Stuart Mulhane would attend the February 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of the commissions to address this request.

Also Matthew Mulhane would like to attend on another matter, about section ten in regards to where burial are taking place at this time.
