

New meeting dates set for - July 15 & Aug 12



On March 19, 2013, my mother  
Eleanor Klasek, died suddenly in  
New Jersey while on a trip with  
the senior center.

The following day I met  
with Paul Turgeon to make  
funeral arrangements. I requested  
to purchase three grave plots -  
one for my mother, one for my-  
self and one for my husband -  
Paul called me back later that  
afternoon and advised me that  
this could not be done. Between  
the sadness and grief and chaos  
of getting her body back here,  
there was a misunderstanding.  
I thought I had to purchase a  
single grave on the right side of  
Central Cemetery. I was shocked  
when we arrived at the cemetery  
after the funeral mass to see  
she was being buried in  
Section 9 - lot 49B. Therefore, (1)

I am asking the cemetery  
commission to allow my husband  
and I to purchase the two  
<sup>GRAVES</sup> ~~lots~~ to the left of her so that  
we will be together and nobody  
will be alone at their final  
resting.

Although I had to leave  
Melbury and not presently living  
there, I will return to Melbury.  
I grew up there, attended Assump-  
tion and Melbury High School  
and raised my children there. I  
still have family and friends  
there and continue to support  
local businesses.

Please consider this petition  
as this will ease some of the  
pain knowing we will be  
together and not leaving her  
alone.
