

**Cemetery Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 5:00 Pm

Attendance: Rob McNeil, Cindy Allard, Marcia Landry. Randy Mogren, Absent: Gil Picard

Also in attendance: Stuart Mulhane, Mulhane Home for Funerals and Paul Turgeon, Turgeon Funeral Parlor.

New Commissioner:

Randy Mogren advised he has been appointed by the Town Clerk to serve on the Cemetery Commission for 3 years. Welcome Randy

New Cemetery Lots:

Lengthy discussion on cost for the new cemetery section, also had input from Mr. Mulhane and Mr. Turgeon, they liked all ideas but thought the burial fees were too expensive, Stuart stated this is not a private or catholic cemetery, it is a public one so fees should be cheaper. Paul expressed that we should be all set with the latest expansion, advised that with past history the new expansion should be good for about 10 years. Rob advised with what he is proposing we could have 1 lot with 3 cremations, which would divide into thirds or if they choose to purchase a double lot them it could hold 6 cremations. Rob also discussed a possible cremation lot area which would be purchased by a family and it would be for cremations only and that area would be used over and over. Stuart suggested that maybe cost of a lot would be about \$500.00 and that most of the monies would go into the cemetery account so it can be used to keep the cemetery up and not in the perpetuation care account that at this point can't be used. Marsha stated she would consider her vote on fees from the last meeting

Mr. Mulhane and Mr. Turgeon left meeting at 6:20 pm

Marcia rescinded the vote at last meeting for 1000.00 per grave

Motion by Marcia for new single grave cost to 600.00 per single grave, 2nd by Randy, all in favor

Rob requested Commissioners to look into the definition of perpetual care, so we can add the definition to the Cemetery Rules and Regulations.

Survey:

The WPI Students area making headway with the survey of the old cemeteries, not they are trying to match headstone with records.

Cemetery Shed:

Marcia advised few things missing on the shed; need to remind the Carpenter School to get it finished before snow flies.

Marx Stone:

Request from a monument company to combine a fur grave lot and a 2 grave lot to make one stone for the 6 graves purchased. Commission denied, Marcia motioned to keep with rules and regulations of monuments, 2nd by Randy, all in favor. Rob will notify the monument company

Budget:

Rob reviewed budget with Commissioners
