### **Minutes of last meeting;**

### **Minutes;**

Asa Waters Mansion and Bandstand Project-

Because Mike Kennedy and Dennis Hill had scheduling conflicts and could not attend this meeting, Tom gave us an update on the bandstand project.

Tom and Dennis did some elevation measurements for the gazebo. Dennis now has to go back to the Asa Waters Task Force and report to them. He has to present this information and get it cleared by the Task Force first, then report to the Town Manager

Because there may be some issues where there may be some things on town property verses Asa Waters property. At this point then it will be determined exactly what other town agencies will assist in getting the gazebo into compliance.

Dennis stated that if all goes well, he will report to us at our next meeting.

Tom had a discussion with Sandy Cristo recently. She said that they are moving forward in attempt to put the TV into the closet area at Asa Waters Mansion. They still have to determine if the wiring and measurements will fit this area. If this were not possible, they would go with the portable cabinet.

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**Downtown Infrastructure;** Mike sent a letter to the Town Manager on the issue of the handicapped accessible parking area. Mike was then advised the letter would be sent to the Safety Committee.

Mike also sent the updated list of all the sidewalk and curb repairs to Mr. McNeil.

Mike received a letter from the AAB in reference to the variance on South Main St. The variance was granted for the angle difference.

New Business;

*\$ 400,000.00*

Senator Mike Moore, was able to secure ~~\$400.00~~ for roadwork and curb cuts in ADA accessible areas in town. Tom then proceeded to read the article that was printed in the Millbury-Sutton Chronicle in the May 1<sup>st</sup> edition about this funding.

Kent brought up a point about changing the timing on the light signals near the bike trail. They do not give an individual an adequate chance to cross the road. This may have to be taken up with Mass DOT.

**Announcements;**

It was mentioned that several members of the commission attended the two-day community access-training program. This informed us about the federal and state ADA regulations.

Nancy made a motion to adjourn the meeting, it was second by Jim. The meeting was adjourned.
