Meeting Minutes;

The minutes for the April 14 meeting were read and accepted as read. Motion by Tom to accept and second by Kent. All members voted unanimously.

Downtown Infrastructure:

Rob McNeil attended our meeting.

Mr. McNeil first thanked some of the members of the Commission who were involved in the Downtown Improvement Study during the winter. He also brought along the final concept drawings; this will address some of the pedestrian and surface treatments that are being considered for the downtown. A couple of these ideas have been pulled out of the Master Plan and are being explored this evening and with our endorsement will be moving forward to the Selectmen for consideration and immediate implementation on a trial basis. This encompasses new crosswalks near the Post Office using a bump out design.

On May 24 our support would be appreciated on this issue at the Selectman's meeting. The issue of Handicap Parking near the Elm Draft House Cinema was discussed. Mr. McNeil explained that this was being considered near the A & D Pizza with some bump outs not only to make them handicap parking spaces but also to slow traffic flow in that area.

As a Commission we gave Mr. McNeil our endorsement to bring these issues to the Select Board.

Mr. McNeil also discussed several other projects that Mike sent him. These are also being considered to be done this construction season.

Asa Waters Bandstand Project:

Article 6.2 on the town warrant concerning the Asa Waters Bandstand passed at the Town Meeting.

We are all happy that it passed but still want to view the blueprints.


Mike will contact Dennis Hill to see if we can possibly look over the plans.
