### **Minutes of last meeting;**

### **Minutes;**

Asa Waters Mansion and Bandstand Project-

There is no update on the bandstand.

After some discussion among the members, Debbi made a motion to have an emergency meeting in two weeks on May 28 at 6:30 to discuss with the Town Manager and the Asa Waters Task Force to give us a realistic plan for the bandstand. If there is no response, a complaint will be filed through an agency to the AAB

### **Downtown Infrastructure;**

The variance that was requested by Mr. McNeil for apex curb cuts verses perpendicular at the intersection of Main St. and Elm St. through the AAB, was not necessary. A variance was not required because the existing curb cuts meet several of the five criteria needed.

Now that it is a new construction season, nothing has been seen by any of the members with regards to the intersection curb cuts, sidewalk curb cuts or making a handicap parking space on Elm St, near the Elm Draft House Cinema.

The only project noticed by Tom was the sidewalk near Fidelity Bank on South Main St. was fixed, but there is a telephone pole in the middle of the sidewalk.
