Minutes of last meeting;

Asa Waters Mansion and Bandstand Project-
Tom had met with Dennis Hill, Rob McNeil and Jim Rivard, who the town asked to come in, he is an engineer who does ADA compliant work.
It was suggested to get a group together of several members of the Disability Commission, Mr. Spain, some members of the Asa Waters Task Force, especially Dennis Hill and Catherine Elliot to discuss the bandstand project. Speak with them and find out how soon we can get this project going.
Mike will contact them and get a meeting set up.

Downtown Infrastructure;

Mike sent the updated list of all the sidewalk and curb repairs to Mr. McNeil. He received a reply back from the DPW director, so we know that Mr. McNeil has the updated list.

Mike received a letter from the AAB in reference to the variance on South Main St. The variance was granted for the angle difference.

New Business;

Senator Mike Moore, was able to secure \$400,000.00 for roadwork and curb cuts in ADA accessible areas in town. Mike then proceeded to read the article that was printed in the Millbury-Sutton Chronicle in the May 1st edition about this funding. He believes that this funding was a part of the Transportation Bill which we believe was passed. This is also an issue that will be brought up at the meeting with Mr. Spain and Mr. McNeil at the bandstand meeting.

Announcements;

It was mentioned that several members of the commission attended the two-day community access-training program. This informed us about the federal and state ADA regulations.

Those who attended received a certificate for completing this two-day seminar.

Kent and Mike gave an update on Mat's Sports Clip. It was viewed by both and coming along well with all the renovations.


NOTE:
