Office up-dates: Julie M. reported there were no office up-dates.

Minutes: Motion to accept minutes from December 11, 2013 meeting was made by Armand White. Seconded by Ron Marlborough. Vote unanimous.

Vouchers to be signed: Vouchers were signed by those present.

Health Agent Report:

61 Stowe Road – Julie V. did site visit for outdoor wood furnace complaint. Observed and photographed stack in regulation, wood burning operation in compliance. Jim Morin has also visited the site and spoke with neighbor, wood dry, seasoned, no violations found. The Board agreed to send letter stating their findings to complainant and cc homeowner.

Panera Bread – Julie V. responded to complaint, patron got sick after eating cream of mushroom soup. Result was stomach flu.

TGI Fridays – Patron found staple like substance in hamburger. Julie V. inspected, it was a piece of grill brush. Reminded general manager all utensils /equipment must be in good working condition.

Direnzo Trucking – Diesel trucks idling more than 10 minutes. John Direnzo stated due to the extreme cold it takes longer to warm the trucks. Julie V. recommended they start and move the trucks onto their own lot.

Millbury Jr./Sr. High School - Roof leaking in kitchen and cafeteria area. Buckets collecting water near service area. Julie V. spoke with Rick Bedard stating power in dishwashing area needed to be shut off due to water leak. Julie V. did follow up, no rain, no leaking. Rick Bedard stated maintenance fixed roof. Ron would like to accompany Julie V. to next inspection. Julie V. also plans to have Building Inspector review roof issue.

In auditorium HVAC system she observed discoloration on ceiling tiles, filters not being changed.

Armand asked if mold issue was resolved, Julie V. stating yes, completely. Armand also recommends Julie V. check filters in all schools due to possible health issue.

Julie V. observed Chinese restaurants on New Year's Eve, very pleased with operations. Feng's Asian Bistro – Sue Wong is training staff and sushi chef on HACCP plan. The PH testing was okay from lab. Waiting for updated HACCP plan.

Recycling – Julie V. obtained information from Holden and Grafton on their recycling streamline program. Discussion tabled.

Calabria – Julie V. stated they are making homemade sausage, adding no preservatives, no HACCP plan needed.

Central Diner – Armand stated they are now closed, the National Bank evicted tenant.

Millbury Discount Deals – Julie V. stated closing soon.

Used Again Marketplace - 75 Elm St. will be opening Saturday, will sell prepackaged foods.

Sudz City – Julie V. stated hot water heater being installed for bathrooms. They do not have to provide hot water for washing machines as long as a sign is posted.

Puffins – Armand asked if they are still regressing. Julie V. stated she will re-inspect this week. Julie V. reviewed high risk inspections with the Board which now require three inspections per year.

Julie V. will be on vacation the week of 1/20/14. Andrea Crete will cover as well as the Board.

A & D Pizza – Jim stated a cease and desist order was issued by the planning board due to façade on addition. Expect to be resolved at next Planning Board meeting.

Kerry Clark gave Derek's update:

Derek appointed to Statewide Public Health Council which meets on Wednesday mornings, therefore, conflict with meetings.

Alliance expanding, Grafton joined with a vote of 4-1. Governing committed will meet in two weeks, Thursday the 30th at the Leicester Police Dept. A Board of Health member or a Town Manager needs to vote to bring Grafton into the alliance.

Accreditation – application submitted.

Kerry stated the standardization working to find a dollar figure for food inspections and housing complaints to continue to provide services once the grants are gone.

Kerry introduced Chris Montiverdi as the new Deputy Director. Chris comes from Leicester and Chairman of their Board of Health, comes well versed in public health. Armand welcomed him stating he's pleased Chris is back into public health.

Kerry Clark gave Karen Clark's update:

Stated the youth survey is complete and UMASS is compiling the results which they expect in April.

This week is the 50th anniversary of the Surgeon General's report on smoking. The alliance will do more media spots in the near future.

The Healthy Market Initiative will continue in the warmer weather, providing fresh produce to local markets.

The next prescription take back day is scheduled for April, the date to be announced.

Kerry asked if the Weekly Updates were being received and are they helpful? Ron finds them informative, Armand receives a phone call if important.

The Board changed the next meeting from January 22, 2013 to January 29th at 7:00 P.M.

Ron update - the family from Pond Terrace has moved to the western part of the state with family and should do well. Again thanked Julie V. and Cheryl Rawinski for all they did for the family.


Ron stated he received a call, woman interested in having a health fair in the spring with the Senior Center and Millbury Health Care. He will get more information and report back.


