Health Agent Update:

60 Grafton Street: Abundance of cats. Julie met the property owner outside and spoke to her about the garbage in the yard. Julie does not believe she will be invited inside. Armand said this was an issue some years back and the lawyer said they were violating her civil rights.

Bellville Lane: Free roaming rooster and chickens: Julie will send out an advisory letter. Very loud roosting new the bedroom window of the complainant. The board agreed this is not acceptable.

Feng: Julie stated the violations were corrected. They voluntarily closed. They needed to demonstrate that they could test the rice themselves and they did that.

Armand stated that all establishments with a history of violations should be inspected more frequently.

United Materials Management: Julie stated this needs to be reviewed. Julie spoke with Bob Spain and they recommend using Faist Engineering, the firm used by the planning department.

MOTION: Armand White made a motion to use Faist Engineering to represent the Millbury Board of Health for the Plan Review for United Materials Management.

City of Worcester Update: Phil Leger reviewed the CMRPHA monthly update.

Public Health Nurse: Cheryl Rawinski stated that the AED for the 3rd EDS Site was approved and should be received soon.

“The Chris Herren Project” - Event at Millbury High School: Ron mentioned that the senator was unable to attend this evening. Spectrum will co-sponsor the event with a donation of \$1,000.00. Cassandra stated that the alliance towns are on board with the exception of Shrewsbury who is already having an event that evening. Cassandra will work with Senator Moore’s office to produce a “save the date” flyer. All discussed light refreshment options such as cookies, brownies, waters. Cassandra thought about 10 to 12 agencies would be present. All discussed the flow of the venue, utilizing library space, hallway space and gym space. Custodians will be responsible for set up and take down. Cassandra stated the panel will consist of Adcare, Spectrum, Chris Herren, Learn to Cope, and the Principal from Recovery H.S. or staff. Advertising options were discussed such as board of selectman meeting, cable, Millbury-Sutton Chronicle and the Blackstone Valley Tribune, The T&G was deemed too expensive. “The Chris Herron Project” is the name of his portion of the event. Possible names for this event: Substance Abuse Awareness & Fair in Collaboration with the Millbury Public Schools Senator Michael Moore’s Office and The Millbury Board of Health. Cassandra stated that the AG’s office may be receptive to being on the panel. She will confirm sponsors. Cassandra stated that an overdose response poster is being worked on. Greg Myers stated that the nurses including the Assumption School nurse will be trained on March 8th on how to administer Naloxone. Cassandra stated that the discounted price is only for first responders which is police and fire and therefore you may want to obtain through those departments. Greg Myers will speak with Chief Desorcy for better pricing.


