Call to Order: Ron Marlborough called to order the meeting of the Millbury Board of Health at 3:30 PM on February 11, 2016 in Millbury Town Hall – Board of Health Office.

Motion to Approve Minutes: Jim Morin made a motion to accept the meeting minutes of January 14, 2016. Seconded by Ron Marlborough. Approved

Office Updates: Judy stated that she returned incompatible AED pads and Battery pack to Region 2 for Zoll compatible replacements. The new AED arrived for the EDS Site at Assumption School. We have been updating the web with Zika virus information. Received zip drive from Jamie Terry with EDS Site information for emergency preparedness.

Health Agent Update:

Phil stated that Julie's update includes, churches and schools are scheduled for next 30 days. DCF is now involved with 130 Park Hill. Julie participated in Title 5 training in Taunton. Blackstone Theater will be inspected soon.

Jim Morin asked what decision had they come to for the theater. Ron stated that each location should have their own permit. This is a large facility for a \$75.00 permit fee and that does not cover the cost of inspections.

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United Materials Management: Phil and Ron both agreed that Scott Lemay gave a great presentation that was very informative.

City of Worcester Update: Phil Leger stated the alliance quarterly meeting is in Grafton from 11:30 to 1:00 on March 16th.

New/Old Business: Ron feels in regards to Wheelabrator that trucks entering from westbound going left into their facility should not be allowed. They need to go to the light and turnaround. Trucks should not be driving through Millbury to go to Wheelabrator. Bob suggested that we check with planning as they may already have an order of conditions.

Clothing Bin By-Law: Jim Morin wanted to revisit this By-Law. Bob Spain wanted to exempt the town from the By-Law as the transfer station has containers.

MOTION:

Jim Morin made a motion to add the Clothing Bin By-Law Article to the warrant pending the changed language exempting Town property and Bob Spain's final approval.

Seconded by Ron Marlborough

All in favour. Approved.

Doreen Goodrich stated that these bins are an issue in her town and she recommended restricting book bins, as well.

“Substance Abuse Awareness Panel & Resource Fair – April 27th at Millbury High School:

Ron stated that in attendance with us is Doreen Goodrich representing Senator Moore's office. Ron asked Cassandra for an update on finances. The health department would cover any minor costs. The sponsorship of the event covers. The fee is \$3,500.00 plus travel and expenses. We are currently short \$1,000.00 plus travel expenses and incidentals. Cassandra presented the flyer for the event. Ron thought the logo section was too crowded. Judy thought the 10k looked like a road race advertisement. Greg Myers stated depending on what support they get from the parent associations they may need to add some additional names. Times were also discussed. Resource Fair from 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM and then close and have Chris Herren Speaker at 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM then he will answer questions then Chris Herren will exit the event and the panel discussion will begin. They all agreed that they would like the resource section to reopen. Doreen will reorganize the flyer. Greg Myers will welcome everyone and introduce Chris Herren. He would like Senator Moore to open up the panel night. Ron asked if Cheryl would sit on the panel. We will have to ask Cheryl. The panel will consist of The Recovery High School, Spectrum, Learn To Cope, Adcare and possibly Cheryl Rawinski. Ron stated the school will hand out flyers. Senator Moore's office will do a press release. Cassandra will invite alliance Town Administrators and Superintendents of Schools including Sutton. Senator Moore's will advertise on a radio show prior to the event. Cassandra asked if we were leaving enough time for the panel. Greg stated that he typically only answers 3 questions. They thought, if the panel participants were agreeable, they could run later than 8:00 PM if they have to. Cassandra will verify with the panel participants. Doreen suggested that they should make an announcement at 8:00 PM that anyone in the audience that wants to leave at 8:00 PM could leave and people who had more questions for the panel could stay a bit longer and the panel would be available. Greg Myers mentioned that some people showed interest in bringing their children to the evening event. Greg said that the evening message is a


