Call to Order: Jim Morin called to order the meeting of the Millbury Board of Health at 4:01 PM on August 10, 2016 in Millbury Town Hall – Board of Health Office.

Office Updates: Food Permits done, Tobacco Permits to be going out, Flu Vaccines will start to be shipped out soon. 24/7 Emergency number posted in office.

Local Upgrade/Variance: None

Health Agent Update: 28 Hayward Lane- House was condemned 7/25/2016, Jim Morin signed Order. All occupant of dwelling were notified of this meeting. Talked about how to go about the clean-up process, Town pays for this but adds liens onto property. Working with the Cat Lady on retrieval of cats, Have A Heart trap set and will be checked on, dryer vent left open if cats are in there so they can get out. Julie will have electricity shut off and at current no hot water. Personal items of occupant are to be stored- computer, laptop, Storage unit? Relative? Mr. Mrozinski spoke about house has always been unkempt, he has lived next door for 37 years. He would like to see the buffer of bushes between yards keep if at all possible. He has some concerns with a vacant house and will be vigilant. The town has no emergency funds available for this situation, has been used in another case. Karyn Clarke thanked Julie for her hard work and for working with the family members in this stressful time. There were 3 dogs that came out of home also, Dan Chauvin took them, 1 had to be put down with conditions, there other 2 were picked up by the Boston Animal Rescue League, and they were also taking care of the bills from time of pick up from the house to care afterwards. Ron did ask Bernie if the DPW could

possibly send a loader in to clean up the yard and take to Wheelabrator. End of conversation was about if the house in the end would need to be torn down, no definite answer yet.

City of Worcester Update: Karyn Clarke talked about an anonymous complaint that went into the Worcester office regarding Smoking at Direnzos Towing. The complaint stated that there was a very heavy smell of smoke in the customer waiting area the day before. A site visit was made by Megan Denubila on 8/10/2016. Karyn explained that its against the law to smoke in the workplace and that the manager at the garage was made aware of the complaint and was given a warning only- no ticket/ or fine was issued. A letter was sent to both Direnzos and a copy to this office. Brief discussion on the law of no smoking in the workplace was had between Ron and Karyn.
