**Call to Order:** Ron Marlborough called to order the meeting of the Millbury Board of Health at 6:35 PM on October 14, 2015 in Millbury Town Hall – Board of Health Office.

**Narcan Discussion:** Cassandra Andersen, Regional Behavioral Health Programs Coordinator said that the State has several ways to access Narcan and different funding sources for the general public. You can purchase at a pharmacy, such as CVS or Walgreens, the cost is about \$100.00 and some private insurances may cover it. You do not need a prescription as the State has a blanket prescription for use by the general public. Mass Health covers Narcan. You can obtain free Narcan at Aids Project Worcester and Learn to Cope at Ad care Hospitals and training is available. Municipal first responders such as police/fire and emts are allowed to carry Narcan after 1 hour mandatory training. The AG's office is working on setting up a Narcan Trust Fund for fire and police. Cassandra offered to assist the fire and police with this process. She will also coordinate "Learn To Cope" to come to the school, however, she would need to know how many participants would be coming.

**Emergency Preparedness-Region 2: Introductions and Discussion:** Jamie Terry, Liz Foley, Alissa Errede and Colleen Bolen discussed WebEOC Drills and Hahn Alerts. Colleen explained that they are here to update the EDS Site Plan information and she reiterated Cheryl Rawinski is the Voting Proxy for the Millbury Board of Health for Region 2. Jamie Terry, Emergency Planner, introduced herself and gave her background information and updated the Board on the EDS Site Plan, she explained her role. She requested updated contact information. The board gave contact information to Jamie Terry to update her data. Judy will send her a list via email this week. Need to discuss and assign the roles for the EDS Site should one be activated. Who is the commander and chief? Wants to arrange a meeting with all departments and their roles, which would include police, fire, and REPC and LEPC players as well.

This is a school issue, should be handled like any other virus, stay home if sick, wash hands.

Ron stated he spoke to Bob Spain and he stated that the board's decision overrides the court decision. Judy wanted to confirm that Katherine does not need labels/stickers or magnets on her containers and can obtain one permit stating Dirty Girl d/b/a Millbury Rubbish, the containers can be purple and she needs to obtain only one permit.
