Office up-dates: Julie M. gave an update for the flu clinic held at the Senior Center, 137 vaccines were administered. The school was given 103 doses and more vaccine will be ordered. Ron asked regarding a second clinic being held at Town Hall. Julie asked the Board if they had any preference for Cheryl scheduling the clinic. The Board prefers a Tuesday evening, 5:00 to 8:00, as the Town Hall is already open and residents will also be in town for the Selectman's Meeting. The Board is looking at November 12<sup>th</sup>. Julie M. will work with Cheryl on this and keep the Board informed.

Meeting scheduled for October 30<sup>th</sup> in the conference room, Jim Morin recommended starting the meeting at 6:30 to have ample time for discussion with rubbish haulers. All agreed. Julie M. informed the Board the Blackstone Valley Chamber of Commerce donated eight tickets to the fundraiser being held at the Felter's Mill on October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

Health Agent Report: Julie V. reopened Subway @ 70 Worcester/Prov. Tpke. They were without hot water for four days. All equipment, utensils, pans, etc. was rewashed. Anything cut and sliced she had them discard.

124 West Main Street – Owner is making very good progress. Has help once a week, big improvement.

301 West Main Street – The trailer has been removed, metals removed, much improvement.

Red Robin – Julie waiting for report from company. Jim stated no flies have been seen, she will re-inspect Thursday. Jim stated they put a fan on overnight to reduce moisture after floor washing.

Kerry Clark gave an update, stating October 26, 2013 prescription take back day, Karen working with police department on this. Advertisements have gone out.

Youth Health Survey has been completed with the schools. Data will be compiled and report will be forthcoming.

Kerry stated the Alliance is starting to locate staff. Julie V. will be here once or twice a week, as well as Mike and Andrea. This relates to the standardization that all inspectors are trained at the same level. Should Julie V. be on vacation, another inspector can cover and get the same service. Kerry stated he knows Armand's stand on this, and Ron stated they are very comfortable with Julie V., as are the businesses. Kerry asks the Board to try this out. Jim stated he has no problem with this to have a new set of eyes. Moving forward, nothing will be done without full board approval.

#### Old Business:

Ron gave an update to Julie V. stating food received from Target: frozen foods they freeze immediately, vegetables and lettuce are donated to the Federated Church, Senior Center and Rhodes House.

Ron thanked Julie V. for her assistance regarding the incident on Riverlin Street on a Saturday. He was called there and had no contact numbers. He then called Julie V., she gave him the necessary numbers for contacting DEP and Dorenzo Towing did the clean up of oil and fuel. He stated when DEP showed up, the clean up was complete and all was handled in a timely manner.


All business not reasonable anticipated to be discussed.
