Call to Order: Ron Marlborough called to order the meeting of the Millbury Board of Health at 4:02 PM on December 3, 2015 in Millbury Town Hall – Board of Health Office.

Office Updates: None

Health Agent Update: Julie VanArsdalen reviewed a few complaints and food inspections including the Chain of Lights Event, no issues. Julie will be re-inspecting 22 Rhodes Street, still have some concerns there. Julie attended the planning department meeting regarding two proposed businesses, both to be located near Wheelabrator. Julie VanArsdalen recommended hiring a consulting engineer to review the proposed recycling business and to review the bio diesel refinery - fuel storage business. Site Assignments would need review, some questions regarding operating 24/7.

City of Worcester Update: Phil Leger reviewed the CMRPHA monthly update. Reviewed staff changes. Also, he stated that ICS training is available for all agents and they recommend participated in this training.

Naloxone Discussion: Cassandra Andersen, Regional Behavioral Health Programs Coordinator explained that the AG's office has released Bulk Purchasing from the State at \$20.00 per dose. She has paperwork on how to order from the state vendor system. Also, a local grant to support overdose prevention is available for events and training and is more flexible but it is for less money as it is for the entire region to use. She stated that it is difficult to obtain Naloxone from the State. The nurses need to be trained at the school and they would like to include Assumption School in this process along with Athletic Directors. The school nurse as a first responder can have the medical director write a prescription and obtain from where they purchase all of their medical supplies. Including other municipal employees such as an athletic director makes it a bit more complicated in regards to paperwork. The schools would only need a slight adjustment to their existing policy for administering Naloxone per Greg Myers. This is at the High School level so far. The high school nurse is not yet trained and they are looking into training. Mr. Myers will reach out to Assumption School.


Educating students and the community on how to react to an overdose:

In regards to the Chris Herron event at the school it is scheduled for April 27th, 2016 at 12:30 at the Gym. He then has an age appropriate message for the younger students. The cost is \$1,500.00 for the afternoon event. Chris Herron does not allow it to be recorded or televised. The school has not booked Chris Herron for the evening portion of the event. He passed on the slot. The cost is an additional \$2,500.00. He was concerned about filling the room and funding the event. Senator Moore stated that he spoke with Spectrum to assist with a panel. Cassandra stated that the grant would possibly be able to assist with some advertising. Cassandra stated that they could cover part of the cost but possibly they could open it up to all of the communities, as this grant is for the region and they can't use all of the of money for one community. Cassandra needs to check in with the other communities in regards to funding this event to make sure they are all on board with this event. They contemplated mandating the athletes to attend. All agreed for a 6:00 PM Start. Roughly 1 hour followed by Q&A session. Cassandra recommended resource tables be available upon arrival. Greg Myers will speak with the Millbury Police Association. Senator Moore will donate \$500.00. Michael Moore will reach out to Spectrum. Mr. Myers will try to book Chris Herron to include an evening event, as well. Julie VanArsdalen with speak to Leicester to see if they would be receptive to this event.


