MINUTES

BOARD OF HEALTH

Date: December 12, 2012

Meeting called to order at 10:00 A.M. by chairman Armand White.

Minutes: A motion to accept the November 28, 2012 minutes was made by Judy O'Connor. Seconded by Jim Morin. Vote unanimous.

Office Update:

Vouchers: Voucher was signed by those present.

Health Agent Report:

12 Draper Road – Derek stated Julie V. resolved and closed the file on this address. She and acting police chief Donald Desorcy visited the residence, the occupant they spoke with stated the trash would be out of there that night. The next inspection revealed all the trash was removed. Armand recommended Julie V. re-inspect from time to time due to the history at that residence.

Royal House of Pizza – Regarding trash complaints, owner stated he would take care of it, however, Derek was there this day, stating two containers, one full with some trash around it, not excessive but it should be emptied. Judy spoke with Joel's Rubbish, he stated he would not empty container until he is paid.

After discussion, the board decided to have Joel empty the container and remove it and the board (Town of Millbury) will pay for the one time dumping. Jim Morin made a motion to ask Joel to remove the trash. Judy seconded the motion for discussion, questioning if the board can designate an outside company for payment. Jim amended the motion to add a lien to the property for payment of trash removal, with the treasurer's office. Vote unanimous.

- Sharps disposal – kiosk coming. Derek stated they are working out a monthly fee for the disposal. Trying to get a better rate with all towns participating.
- Judy asked Derek for more needle clipping devices. Very popular, giving them to people who take needles daily. Asked if device (holds 1500 needles) will be disposed of in the sharps kiosk. Derek stated yes and he will try to get more for her office and the board of health office.
- Quarterly report – Jim questioned the letterhead City of Worcester. Derek stated collectively, all towns are together. The coalition in itself is not a legal entity. The City of Worcester bills the town of Millbury, the report states what the City has done on behalf of Millbury’s board of health.
- Reminder, regional meeting is tomorrow 12/13/12 at 1:00 P.M.
- Derek stated the upcoming flu season could be the worst since 2009.

Old Business:




Other Business:
