Office up-dates: Julie M. stated the Wheelabrator update will be presented at the March 19th meeting by Jim Malley. Bob Spain was also asked to attend, however, he has a conflicting meeting. Ron wants a copy of the site assignment given to Bob. Julie M. will forward to him. Jim and Ron updated Seth regarding Wheelabrator's request for use of ground water for their ash and tower. Ron recommended that meeting be changed to 6:00 P.M., Jim Morin agreed.

Minutes: Motion to accept the minutes of February 26, 2014 meeting was made by Ron Marlborough. Seconded by Jim Morin. Vote unanimous.

Vouchers to be signed: Vouchers were signed by those present.

Health Agent Report:

Julie V reported:

Elmwood St. School – complaint of moldy musty odor in area of room 216, both upstairs and down, also rooms 122 and 117, possibly coming from duct work. Julie V. inspected (pictures taken) and determined duct work needs to be cleaned. Rick Bedard is pricing for company to come in during April vacation to clean entire ducts throughout the school.

Panera Bread – Julie V. inspected, Gentleman in charge has no serv safe, allergen or anti choking certification. He will pursue with his manager. Overall cleanliness is better.

Feng's Asian Bistro – Jennifer trained entire staff and HACCP plan is now up to date.

Mayfair Drive – Julie V. spoke to complainant, she is not a tenant, this is a single family home, heat is kept at 64 during daytime. Case closed.

Grove Street – Julie V. inspected, heat in apartment is 72.3 degrees. Case closed.

Seth reported:

Health survey report, some results are back, reviewing for data, expect results in April.

Prescription Take Back Day is April 26, 2014.

MOAPC – more overdose prevention material forthcoming.

Jim asked update on prescription software control crossover. Seth explained that's part of the prescription program, however, very sensitive material.

Rhodes to Recovery – Karen Clark will speak with them regarding tobacco abuse. Julie V. also reaching out to them for substance abuse speaker and trying to educate them as they need services.

Zach is working on Health Markets and Julie V. stated someone interested in opening a farmers market in the Felter's Mill. She forwarded info to Zach to follow up.

Ron stated Millbury Health Care will be having their Health Fair on May 31, 2014. He stated the coalition may want to have a table there. Event will include the coalition, Millbury Board of Health and The Lions Club will have their sight mobile as well.

Old Business:

Ron referred to house set for demolition on Pond Terrace, wants Julie V. to make sure pre and post pest control order is in place with building inspector.

Ron reported on Superior Waste, went to court with Julie V. last week, owner did not show up. Owner sold off his front end loader. Ron noticed him picking up rubbish on Elm Street.

Jim addressed rubbish hauler recycling. Julie V. had researched, stated streamlining is not going to happen in Millbury, recommended following state regulations. Jim feels the haulers should be reporting tonnage. Julie V. will review state regulations regarding tonnage reporting and will report back in May. Jim wants something in place by July 1st, 2014 if warranted.
