The Board asked Chief Moore to talk to Chief Sampson and get a survey of police chief salaries. They would like to invite Retired Chief Sampson to the next meeting.

You need to make strict criteria to give to the assessment center.

Chief Moore said that there is interest in former chiefs for this department.

Selectman Ashmankas' #1 quality would be someone who has gained both respect of all and the ability to discipline.
