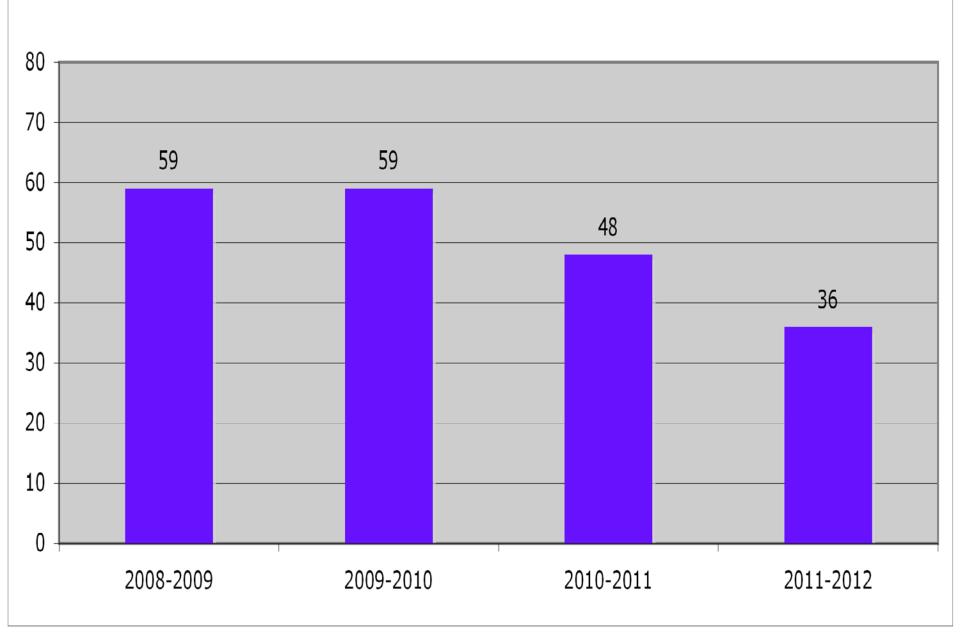
School Choice In-Coming 2008-2012



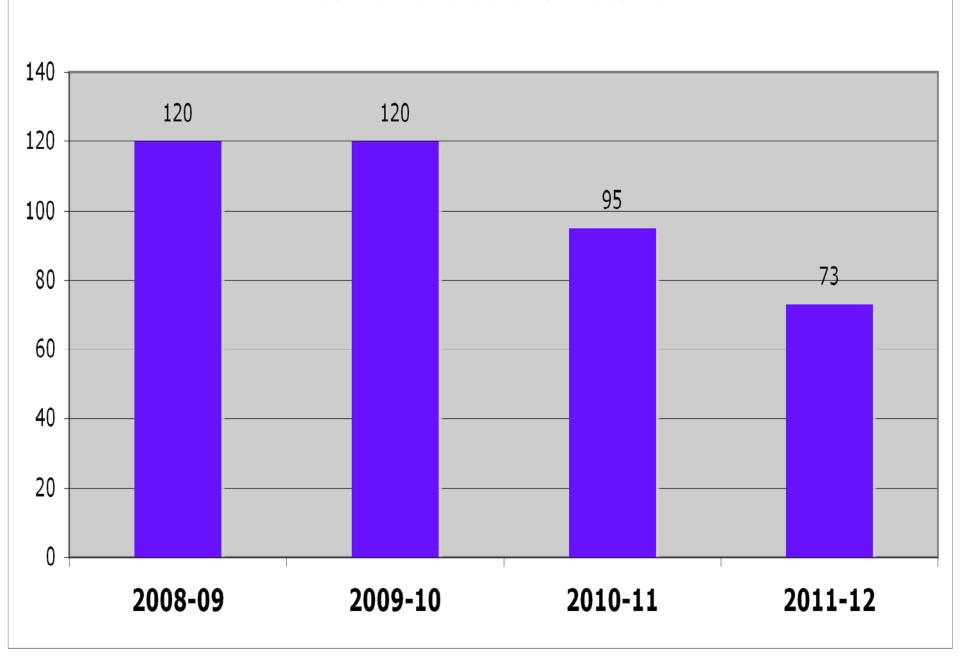
School Choice Out-Going 2008-2012



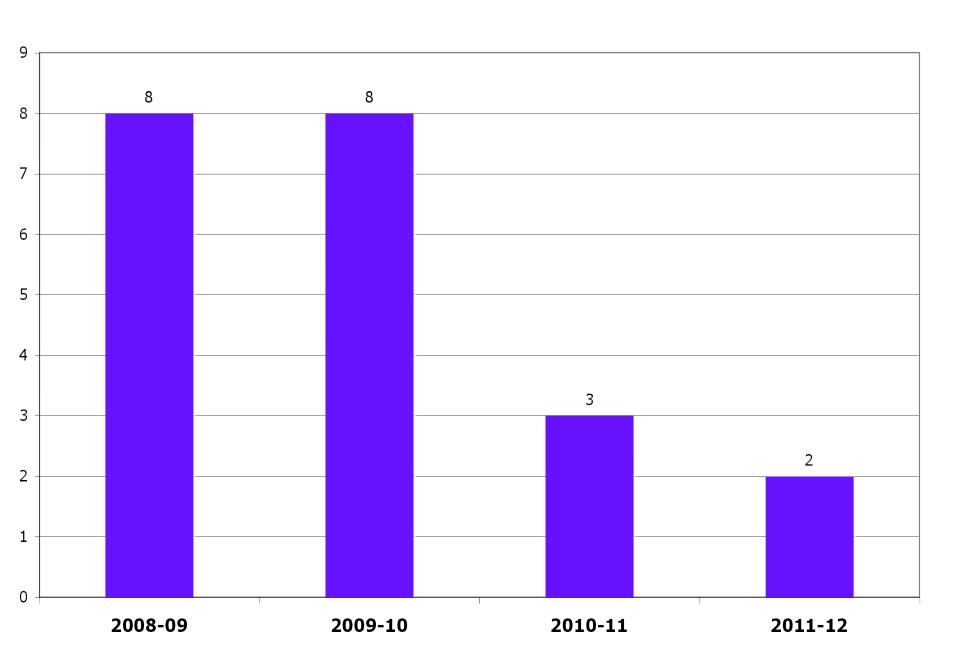

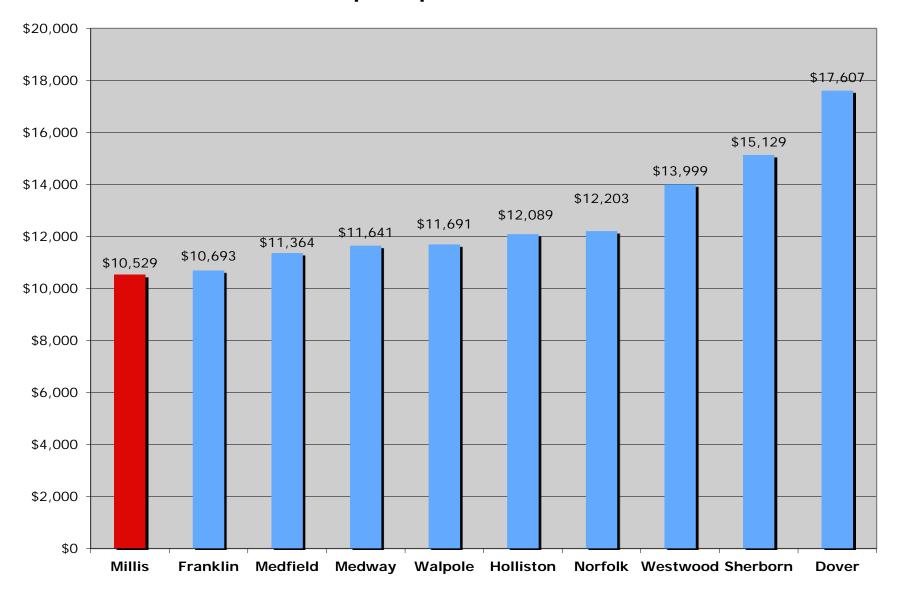
Private and Home Schooled 2008-2012



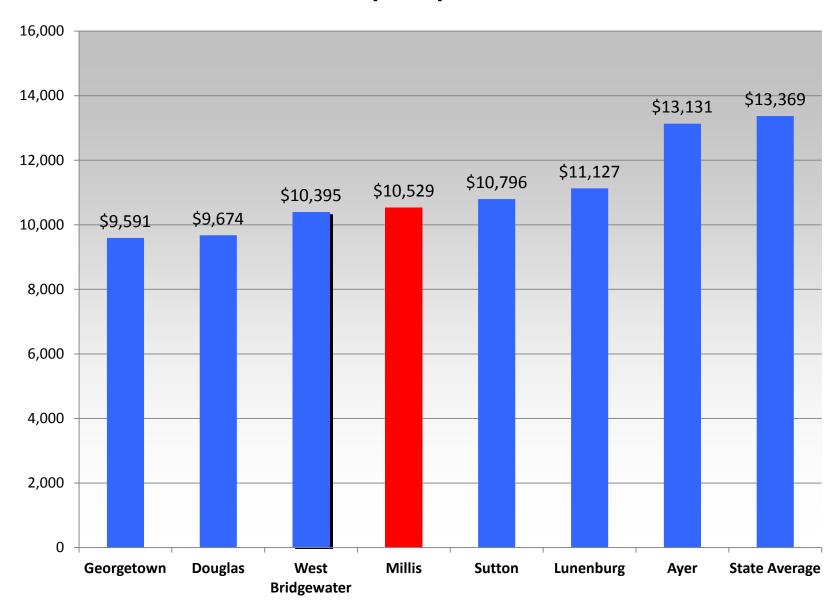
Charter School Millis Enrollment 2008-2012



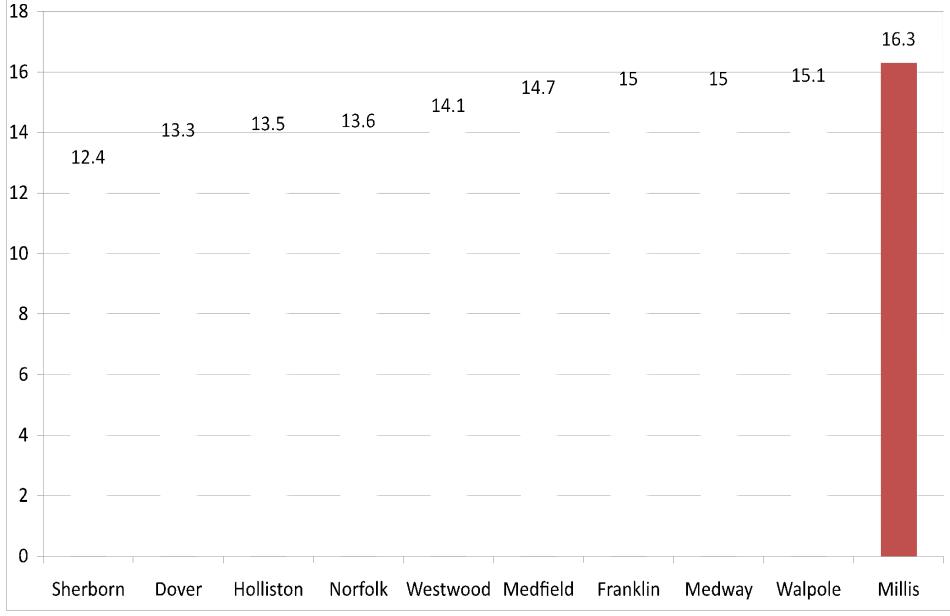
Per Pupil Expenditures FY11

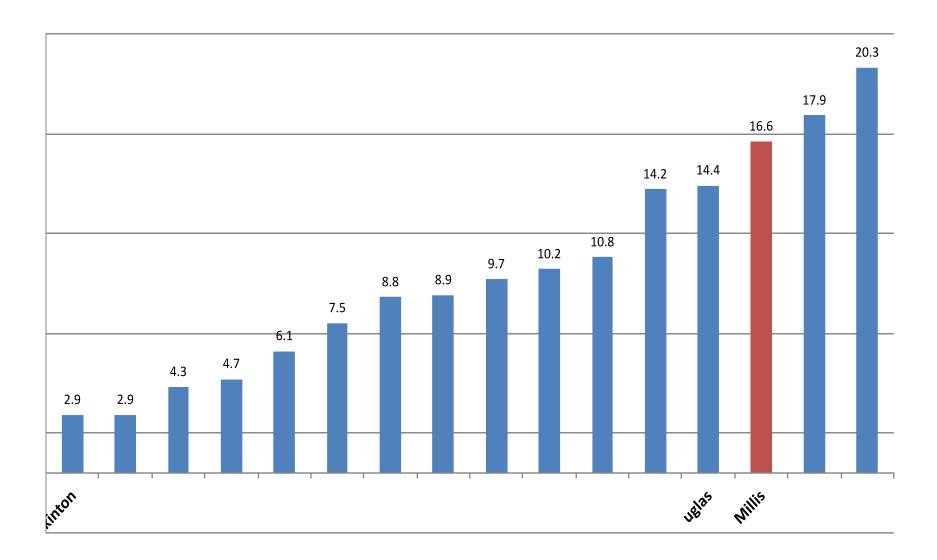

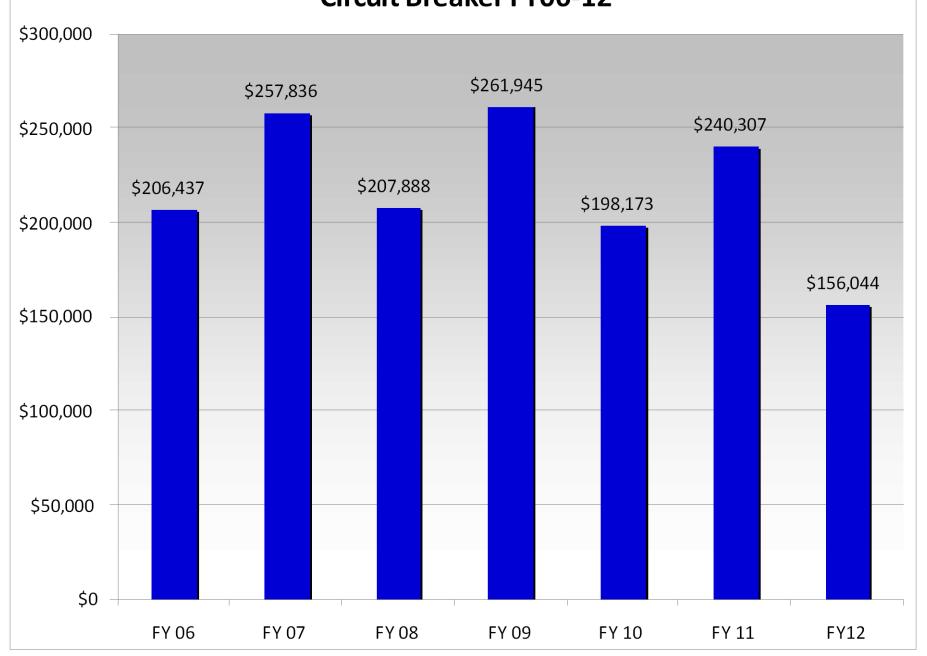


Student to Teacher Ratio

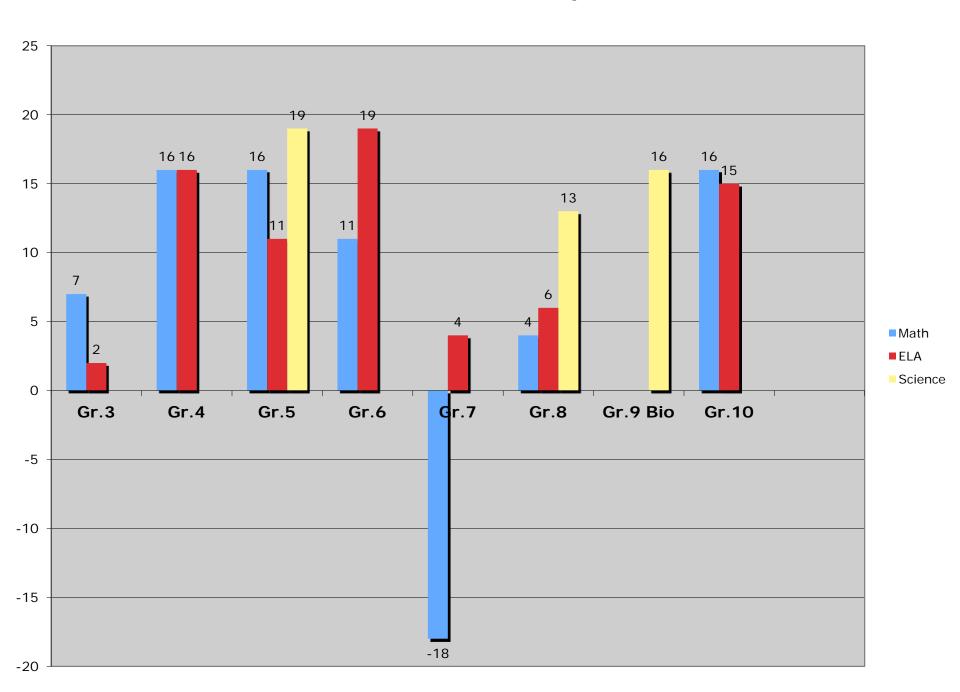




Circuit Breaker FY06-12

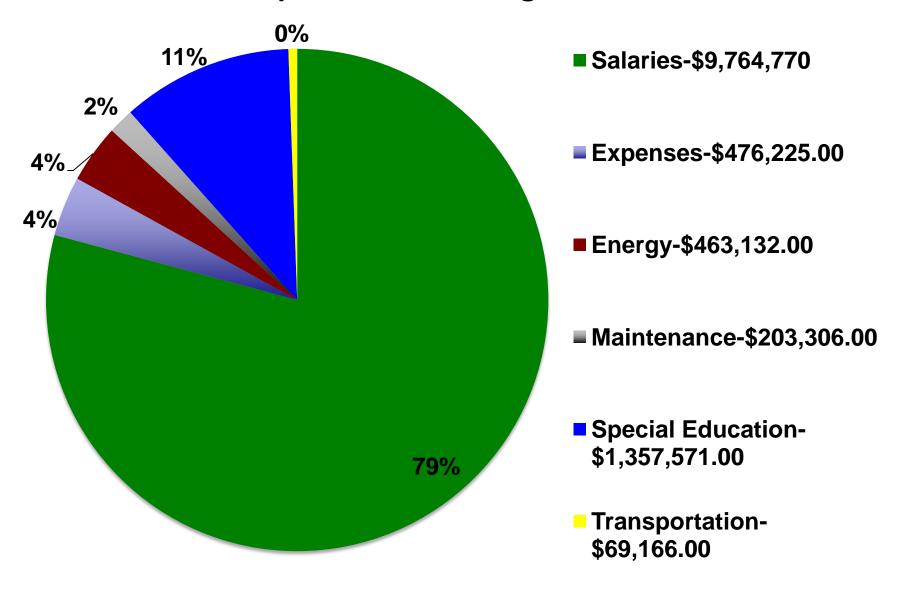

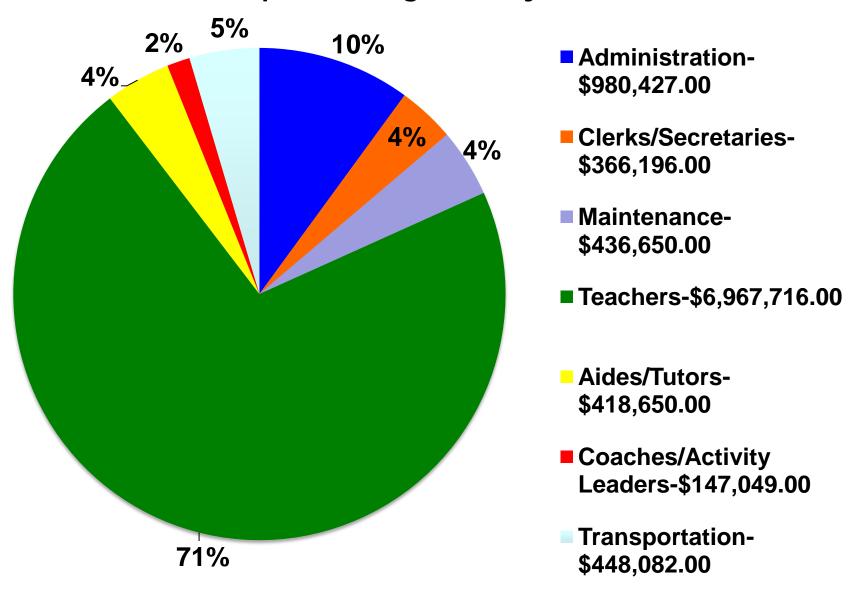
