As you may recall in FY16 the Department did not purchase a new vehicle as part of the annual vehicle replacement schedule. Consequently, we are looking to replace two aging marked police cruisers, a 2007 Crown Victoria, and a 2011 Crown Victoria both with in excess of 90,000 miles, and almost double in wear and tear due to idle time and the type of driving that is typical of a marked police cruiser.
