Suggestions were made to charge \$100.00 yearly fee for use of all cardio and Curves equipment. The room would be open the same hours as the Town Hall, including Monday night and closing at noon on Fridays. Patty will talk to Safety Signal to try to determine the best computer access information for usage per person. She is hoping to have the room set up by the end of June.
- Tasty Tuesdays will continue through the end of June, There are 8-10 people who attend every week and they enjoy the pizza
- Memorial Service Brooks will check with Rev Jen for availability on either 6/4 or 6/6. Patty will invite Selectmen to attend.
- Volunteer Luncheon Patty needs help stuffing the envelopes for invitations Chris volunteered to do them while she baby sits her adorable granddaughter.
- There is an Open Space Study currently on the Town Website. Selectmen have asked that we put in newsletter asking all seniors to please voice their interests as it seems a great many of the younger population have already replied.
