## #CE225-0375 Notice of Intent, Public Hearing, Main St./Rte. 109 Culvert

The public hearing was opened at 7:30 p.m. with notice being read by Dr. Lederer, Chair.

Mr. Carter, representing the Town of Millis DPW, presented the application and plans for the removal and replacement of the failing culvert under Main St./Rte. 109. Mr. Carter described the project location as within the right of way and drainage easements on Route 109 (Main Street), approximately 175 feet northeast of the intersection of Milliston Road and Main Street. The applicant, he said, proposes to replace the existing culvert with a new 42-inch reinforced concrete pipe. Incidental work will include replacing the downstream concrete headwall with a new precast concrete headwall and repairing the upstream stone masonry headwall.

Mr. Carter stated that the Town would like to get the work done as soon as possible. The project is out to bid, he said, and bids are due November 15, 2012. The actual installation of the pipe should be a two-day effort, he said.

On a motion made by Ms. Rich, seconded by Mr. Lee, it was voted unanimously to close the public hearing at 7:47 p.m.

On a motion made Ms. Gavin, seconded by Ms. Rich, it was voted unanimously to issue an Order of Conditions for the project, pending assignment of a DEP File number by DEP. (Note: DEP assigned File#CE225-0375 and the Order of Conditions was issued November 2, 2012)

There being no further business, on a motion made by Mr. Lee, seconded by Ms. Gavin, and voted unanimously, the meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
