CPA Surcharge Informal Discussion Chris Smith

Mr. Smith updated the Committee on discussions regarding the possibility of increasing the surcharge for the Community Preservation Act. The CPC reviewed an analysis spreadsheet comparing the current 1% surcharge with a 3% surcharge. Increasing the surcharge would significantly increase the amount of state matching funds, Mr. Smith stated. He said that the monies could be used to fund some of the athletic fields project currently under review by the Selectmen. Provided the athletic fields warrant article passes, "the state match increases significantly and the match could be used for a portion of the debt for the fields," Mr. Smith said. Mr. Smith stated that he is not proposing anything at this time, but wanted to update the CPC on some ideas that had been suggested. Mr. Smith stated that the Selectmen would be discussing the athletic fields article at their meeting on Monday, October 6, 2014.
