South Shore Habitat for Humanity – Noreen Browne Affordable Housing Informal Discussion

Ms. Browne had emailed the CPC and requested an informal discussion regarding affordable housing opportunities in Millis. She described what her organization does. Ms. Browne stated that they have been offered the opportunity to purchase land from a landowner in Millis on George Avenue. They would propose to build a single family affordable home using the 40B/Comprehensive Permit or Special Permit process, she said. If possible, they would seek CPA funds for the purchase of the property. Ms. Browne said that they would also be interested in discussing other abutting properties in the George Street area that are owned by the Town. According to Ms. Browne, Habitat for Humanity of Cape Cod has successfully used a model of CPC funded land acquisitions for affordable housing in many of the Cape Cod towns. They would like the opportunity to pursue this concept in Millis.

The CPC was in favor of discussing this concept in the future once Ms. Browne further investigated the property. She was told that to donate land, it would have to go through the Town Meeting process for approval. It was suggested that she follow-up with Ms. Dumont, Ms. Scannell and the Board of Selectmen/Town Administrator and then come back to the CPC with a funding request.
