Chris Smith called the meeting to order at 7:33 PM.

### Library Project Costs:

Wayne Klocko:

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the disposal of the ground water at the library site and the discovery of contamination. During digging of the retaining wall contamination was discovered in the ground water. The test came back with 12 PPB (parts per billion) and the limit is 5 PPB. Discharging or dewatering is now discharged into the town's sewer system. Several monitoring wells are being used during the remainder of the dewatering which will last approximately a month. The DEP visited the site last Thursday and did not give any indication of further actions. The cost of testing to determine if the contamination is at the library site was not included in the project's contingency fund. The fund covers \$190,000.00 of which approximately \$60,000.00 has been incurred to date to cover the dewatering costs. Additional dewatering costs are estimated at \$40,000.00. The cost would deplete the contingency fund and there are twelve months of construction remaining on the project.
