Oak Grove Farm Revolving Fund Request to Spend Beyond Limit:

Steve MacInnes:

The Oak Grove Farm Revolving Fund has a spending limit of \$15,000.00 per year. In FY13 the commission received approximately \$19,000.00 in revenue from field use fees. Their account has a balance of approximately \$59,000.00. In previous years a lot of the maintenance was done by volunteers. Most of the expenses are for maintenance of the farm; mowing, brush removal. Maintenance is performed annually and bi-annually.

Some expenses incurred this fiscal year are:

Field repair: \$4,480.00
Tree Removal: \$4,340.00
Footbridge Survey & Postage: \$2,557.03
New Soccer Field Project: \$1,400.00
Parking Lot Repair: \$1,150.00
Clearing undergrowth/open trails: \$2,175.00

The fund also pays secretarial wages and DPW staff wages for maintenance of the fields.

Discussion: The committee asked the Oak Grove Farm Commission to provide a budget analysis for FY15 including estimated maintenance costs and revenues.

Susan Vecchi made a motion to recommend a temporary increase to the Oak Grove Farm Revolving Fund to \$30,000.00 in FY14; Jim Smith seconded. Vote: 6/0 motion carries unanimously.

Old/New Business:

Susan Vecchi made a motion to recommend approval of the WB Mason invoice in the amount of \$19.42 for a nameplate; Jim Smith seconded. Vote: 6/0 motion carries unanimously.
