

**Airplane Noise Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes**

Moderator Walsh called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Cronin Conference Room of the Town Hall.

Moderator Walsh swore in the Committee members who then introduced themselves.

Ms. Conlon, Ms. Musto, and Ms. Fagan all made opening remarks thanking the committee members for their participation and clarified the charge and role of the committee as an advisory committee to the Board of Selectmen.

Ms. Kinsella moved, Mr. Blanchard seconded and the Committee voted 8-1 to appoint Mr. Keohane and Ms. Musto as Co-Chairs of the Airplane Noise Advisory Committee.

Ms. Musto moved, Ms. Killingback seconded and the Committee voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Blanchard as Secretary of the Airplane Noise Advisory Committee.

Committee members re-introduced themselves and each gave a brief statement of their background and their specific concerns and issues relative to airplane noise and traffic. The concerns expressed included noise, health effects, the increase in the amount of planes, the low elevations of planes, concentrated flight paths, financial impacts on property value, and pollution.

Mr. Keohane gave an overview of his recent efforts to work with Mayor Walsh and the City of Boston on airplane related issues.

The Committee discussed various goals including collecting and analyzing data, increasing the spread and altitude of planes flying over Milton, utilizing our elected State and Federal representatives, potential lawsuit opportunities, and possible grant and health study opportunities.

The next Airplane Noise Advisory Committee was scheduled for Wednesday, November 5, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in the Cronin Conference Room, Town Hall.

The meeting adjourned at 9:04 p.m.
