**Ms. Musto called the meeting to order at 7:40pm in the Carol A. Blute conference room.**

**Citizen Speak: Jason Ingraham, 396 Canton Avenue, addressed the committee and said he would like to listen to the meeting.**

**Welcome Introduction of New Members:**

**Members introduced themselves and gave brief statements of their background as well as their concerns relative to airplane noise & traffic. Discussion of committee reappointments- some members noted that one former member of the committee was not reappointed. Caroline Kinsella said that Selectmen are responsible for committee reappointments.**

**Conflict of Interest/ Open Meeting Law Discussion**

**Barbara Martin reviewed the Conflict of Interest and Open Meeting Law Guide. There was a broader discussion regarding potential conflicts.**

**Roxanne spoke about her concern about specific postings and misinformation on the BOS Fair Skies Facebook page. She read two postings from the Facebook page aloud. Caroline Kinsella referenced a negative quote about the Board of Health on the Facebook page.**

**Andy, Jenn & Muna are on the grassroots committee. They were asked about their roles on that committee. They were asked to go back to their grassroots committee and have these**

postings removed as they are inaccurate and can also potentially negatively affect our committee. There was a lot of discussion about responsibilities of being on both of these committees. The Airplane Noise Advisory Committee needs to work cohesively and have a unified front. David Godine stated that as members of this committee what we say in a public forum is public. Roxanne stated that going forward, we all have to be on the same page as it is a whole Town issue. Barbara stated that we speak as a voice for the Town and it has to be solution based. The committee was reminded that we are an advisory committee to the Board of Selectmen.

David Godine asked Caroline Kinsella if she was receiving information from Daryl Poindexter/East Boston, Logan CAC rep. She was not-David said he would forward his information to Barbara. David also thought that previous Boards of Selectmen did not aggressively challenge FAA changes and he is happy to see that this Board of Selectmen is serious about this issue. This may require money and legal action. He also stated that there is no vehicle of communication in the Town.

Jen Goonan said that the grassroots committee is speaking to an aviation attorney from California. She asked about our strategic plan and who the Town has spoken with.

Roxanne passed out the Airplane Noise Advisory Committee charge to review.

#### Update on 4L RNAV's

Letter from Town Attorney was sent to the FAA in response to the proposed 4 L RNAV'S. The Board of Health also submitted a letter to the FAA and other officials in response to the proposed 4LRNAV's.

#### Town of Milton Website Updates- Discussion about how best to optimize the website.

Andy suggested posting the Town of Milton response letter and Board of Health letter to the website. Discussed posting committee charge, committee approved minutes to website. Also, discussed how and where to best post information about upcoming meetings. Could the committee have an email address of it's own? Discussion of how to best reach out to residents to provide them with information.

Caroline Kinsella said that she would work with Rob Mallett, IT, to post minutes that were approved.

CAC Updates- Caroline Kinsella, Massport CAC rep. stated that the 2 previous Massport meetings were not productive. The second meeting did not have a quorum. A new Massport meeting date for the fall has yet to be set. Caroline stated that she would meet with the Selectmen to give them a report.

#### Discussion of Next Steps

Barbara Martin will try to reach out to former Logan CAC chair, Sandra Kuntz, to see if she would be interested in attending a meeting of ours to discuss the CAC.

Muna handed out a Boston Globe article about Sandra to the committee.

There was a discussion about whether or not to have subcommittees. Andy handed out paperwork about Proposed ANAC Sub-Committees. It was mentioned that we are a volunteer committee and small enough that we can function at this time without subcommittees, as they take a lot of additional time. We discussed the importance of finding out the history of decision making in the CAC and FAA with regards to Milton in order to strategize. The consensus was to formulate 3-4 questions to discuss at our next meeting that we could ask former CAC reps in order to understand the history of some of the decisions that have affected Milton. The committee wanted to consider having a joint meeting with the Board of Selectman and some other agencies such as the DEP, State Board of Health, Attorney General. There was also discussion about possibly hiring an aviation specialist.

David Burns said that we need to be unified and working with other communities as well as our Congressional delegation. Stephen Lynch has been a supporter of the Town on this issue.

Andy brought up the City of Santa Cruz- where the FAA met with the community, asking why this can't happen here.

The issue regarding the Boston Fair Skies Facebook page was again discussed with regards to talking about personal responsibility and the need for a unified voice. The members from the grassroots committee that also sit on the Airplane Noise Advisory Committee were asked to have the information that was identified on the BOS Facebook page be removed.

Andy will meet by phone for our next meeting that is on August 24<sup>th</sup>.
