- 4. Ms. Fagan and Ms. Conlon thanked Town department heads and Town Accountant Amy Dexter for their aid and cooperation working on the budget .The Warrant Committee and all in attendance applauded Ms. Fagan's achievement in meeting the target budget cut for all non- School budgets.
- 6. Mr. Adamcyzk and Mr. McLaughlin discussed the library budget.
- 7. Ms. Fagan and Ms. Conlon discussed the effect of departmental budget cuts on the other non-School budgets.
- 8. Mr. Walker addressed the Committee with objectives for and reflections on Milton Public Schools. Ms. Gormley then provided a detailed account of what the proposed budget cuts would entail at the elementary schools and middle school. Mr. Pavlicek did the same for Milton High School.
