MILFOIL UPDATE: Peter discussed latest status. (85 acres were not treated this last year).

TOWN MEETING STRATEGY: Marie showed the flyer that was going to be passed out at Town meeting regarding the 2 articles (Milfoil Control and LUCT) that the Conservation was backing. Discussion of Pros and Cons followed. Marie asked for volunteers to hand out the flyers. (Bob volunteered).

WETLANDS RESTORATION AND MITIGATION INVENTORY: Paul Stinson talked about the status of the project. (Currently on hold due to availability of Town Administrator).

GOALS FOR 2011: Marie talked about priorities for Con. Com. No. 1, is measuring "P" to protect water quality, and educating public about the dangers of too much Phosphorus getting into our lakes. Others mentioned were Storm Water runoff problems, and identifying Wild life Corridors. Paul Stinson mentioned that maybe we should only concentrate on one item and let the public know how we're doing.
