Chair Cristina Ashjian called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM, and the Minutes of the last meeting on October 8, 2014 were approved as written. Cristina informed the Commission that Mark Borrin has resigned due to increased personal commitments. Bruce Worthen will be relocating to Manchester in December so his resignation will be forthcoming. Cristina will assume Bruce's role as Heritage Committee representative on the Village Vision Committee.

The Commission discussed the tentative "Village Boundaries" map from the Village Vision Committee. It was noted that any boundary change would require zoning amendments. In light of the potential zoning issues the Committee agreed to clarify its earlier "Village Boundary" map to state that it is the position of the Heritage Commission that the zoning boundary should extend from Blake Road along Route 25 to Berry Pond only (just past Old Route 109).

The Commission received updates on various activities and committees. The Conservation Committee held a site walk and informational meeting on November 8th on the potential Lee's Pond Preserve, both of which were well attended. The Heritage Commission will continue to support efforts to conserve the property because of its historical and archaeological significance. There are have been no MPIC or Moultonborough Grange Committee meetings or updates.
