Chair Cristina Ashjian called the meeting to order at 5:35 PM. The Minutes of the April 19th, 2010 meeting were approved without changes. Cristina announced that the Long Island Inn was added to the state Register of Historic Places and distributed relevant media reports.

The archaeology project at the Moultonborough Falls industrial mill site is underway; a Plymouth State University graduate student will prepare a preliminary survey of the site for his spring project. Cristina and Planner Dan Merhalski met with the student and two DHR staff members to walk the site on Monday, May 10th; any period images of the site are welcome.

Cristina provided a brief update on the planning underway for the Community Landmarks Tour (August 8th); letters to potential tour sponsors were sent out on May 14th. In late May, NH Preservation Alliance staff will come to Moultonborough to visit the tour sites in order to discuss property specific concerns such as appropriate parking for the day of the tour.

The Commission then discussed and compiled a list of good local examples of connected farm buildings throughout the town for possible inclusion in Prof. Thomas Hubka's presentation scheduled for July 7th at the Moultonborough Library.
